AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE
CITY MANAGER TO WITHDRAW FROM MEMBERSHIP IN THE
MEDWAY DRUG ENFORCEMENT COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENT.

WHEREAS: On February 13, 1984, this Council adopted Resolution No. 10-84 authorizing the City Manager to obtain membership in the MEDWAY Drug Enforcement Council of Government ("MEDWAY");

WHEREAS: The City is a member of the Medina County Drug Abuse Commission;

WHEREAS: The Chief of Police has recommended that the City withdraw from membership in MEDWAY; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 167.02(D), the City may withdraw as a member of MEDWAY upon formal action by this Council as provided herein and upon sixty (60) days notice to MEDWAY.

WHEREAS: THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRUNSWICK HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to withdraw from membership in MEDWAY and shall be authorized to execute any documents, upon approval of the Law Director, to effectuate same.

SECTION 2: That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to serve a certified copy of this Resolution upon MEDWAY immediately upon passage.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety or welfare, and for the additional reason that immediate passage is necessary to comply with the sixty (60) day notice requirement. Therefore the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the required number of votes or from the earliest time allowed by law.
