MOTION: A motion to allow the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the Brunswick City Schools to provide bus transportation to the Brunswick Recreation Center for the Safe Haven after school program.

BACKGROUND: The City of Brunswick has hosted a safe haven after school program for over the past ten years. The City partners with the Brunswick City Schools to offer bus transportation to the recreation center. This agreement would be for the upcoming 2018/2019 school year.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY: The financial amount for the transportation agreement would be \$14,054 with one payment (\$7,027) in December of 2018 and final payment of (\$7,027) in May of 2019. RECOMMENDED ACTION: It would be the recommendation to pass this motion to allow the City of Brunswick to enter into an agreement with the Brunswick City Schools for the transportation of the students to the Brunswick Recreation Center during the 2018/2019 school year.
