DISCUSSION: Radios for Safety Services

BACKGROUND: This is a planned capital purchase in our approved 2019 budget. We will be requesting an emergency with the suspension of the rules as there is current rebate pricing from the radio manufacturer that expires at the end of March. In addition, there is an approximate 90-day timeline for radio deployment once they are ordered, programmed and installed as well as we are working in cooperation with our partners in Brunswick Hills who contract with us for dispatch services.

In consultation with the Finance Director we will be making the request for one purchase in an amount not to exceed \$280,000 and then it will be broken out from each division budget as follows:

Division of Police radios (mobile and portable) - \$171,000

Division of Fire radios (mobile and portable) - \$85,000

911 Dispatch Center - \$24,000
