MOTION: Motion authorizing the City Manager to advertise for public bids for the 2019 Asphalt Road Program.

BACKGROUND: The proposed project will seek to replace the deteriorated surface with asphalt on various streets throughout the City, improving neighborhood accessibility and safety to the traveling public.

PURPOSE AND EXPLANATION: The purposed project will resurface areas of deteriorated asphalt pavement on various streets throughout the City and will also overlay deteriorated concrete streets with asphalt pavement. Most of the work areas will be on residential streets, with some additional spot repair areas on Pearl Road. The scope of work was determined through field observations by the Engineering and Service Departments. This project is only for asphalt repairs; concrete street repairs are being addressed in a separate concurrent project.

IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE: Should authorization to bid be secured at the March 11, 2019 Committee-of-the-Whole meeting, the project will be advertised in late March. Construction is anticipated to begin on or about May 1.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION: 2019 Asphalt Road Program - - - 332-0473-56881 - -

FINANCIAL SUMMARY: The project is being primarily funded with Road Levy dollars, with additional funding from the Road Fund for repairs on Pearl Road. Preliminary construction cost estimate of the combined asphalt and concrete program is \$810,000.00. Engineering and inspection costs are covered under separate contracts and are excluded from this combined cost estimate.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Passage of a motion which authorizes the City Manager to advertise for and seek public bids for the 2019 Asphalt Road Program.

BACKGROUND: The proposed project will seek to replace deteriorated concrete panels and joints on various residential streets throughout the City, improving neighborhood accessibility and safety to the traveling public.

PURPOSE AND EXPLANATION: The proposed project will remove and replace areas of deteriorated concrete pavement on various streets throughout the City. The scope of work was determined through field observations by the Engineering and Service Departments. This project is only for concrete street repairs; asphalt street repairs are being addressed in a separate concurrent project.

IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE: Should authorization to bid be secured at the March 11, 2019 Committee-of-the-Whole meeting, the project will be advertised in late March. Construction is anticipated to begin on or about May 1.
