LEGISLATION: **RES. NO. 63-19** - An emergency resolution amending Resolution No. 21-17 by increasing the 2019 contract price for the provision of grass/weed mowing, debris clean-up services and branch trimming for 2019. - **1st Reading** (To be brought from Building & Building Code Committee, Administration/Ryan Lutz)

BACKGROUND: Resolution 21-17 was passed on April 10, 2017 to award a 3 year contract to Always Green Landscaping, LLC to provide grass/weed mowing, debris clean-up services and branch trimming annually through 2019.

PURPOSE AND EXPLANATION: The purpose of this legislation is to provide for the contracting of mowing, branch trimming and debris clean up throughout the city for violations of the city through this current growing season. Due to high non-compliance in 2019, an estimated additional \$4,000 will be needed to complete this enforcement activity through the end of the growing season this year.

IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE: Work is ongoing.

AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 21-17 BY INCREASING THE 2019 CONTRACT PRICE FOR THE PROVISION OF GRASS/WEED MOWING, DEBRIS CLEAN-UP SERVICES AND BRANCH TRIMMING FOR 2019.

WHEREAS: On April 10, 2017, City Council adopted Resolution No. 21-17 awarding a three (3) year Contract to Always Green Landscaping, LLC to provide grass/weed mowing, debris clean-up and branch trimming for 2017, 2018 and 2019 relative to properties in violation of the City's Property Maintenance Code, in an annual amount not to exceed \$23,700.00; and

WHEREAS: Due to high non-compliance in 2019, an estimated additional \$4,000.00 will be required to complete enforcement of non-compliant properties in 2019.

WHEREAS: THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRUNSWICK HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1: That Resolution No. 21-17 is hereby amended to increase the 2019 Contract price for the provision of grass/weed mowing, debris clean-up and branch trimming in an amount not to exceed \$27,700.00.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare, and safety and for the additional reason to allow enforcement of non-compliant properties in 2019. Therefore, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the required number of votes or from the earliest time allowed by law.
