AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION EXPRESSING DISSATISFACTION WITH
THE BRUNSWICK POST OFFICE.

WHEREAS: The Brunswick Post Office has failed to meet stated deadlines to repair mailboxes within the City of Brunswick.

WHEREAS: THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRUNSWICK HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1: This Council does hereby express its dissatisfaction with the Brunswick Post Office for its failure to meet stated deadlines for the repair of mailboxes within the City.

SECTION 2: This Council urges the U.S. Post Office to make the planned necessary repairs to the Winchester and Laurel Road mailbox areas immediately.

SECTION 3: That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the Ohio House of Representatives and Senate, Ohio Attorney General and Ohio Governor upon the effective date hereof.

SECTION 4: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare, and safety and for the additional reason that it is necessary to immediately repair mailbox areas in the City. This Resolution shall be effective upon receipt of the requisite number of votes or from the earliest time allowed by law.
