MOTION: Motion authorizing a change order in the amount of \$55,628.00 to Marks Construction, Inc. for the Plum Creek Restoration and Drainage project

BACKGROUND: Additional tree planting and targeted invasive plant species removal was added to the project. The additional trees were part of the Medina County Park District master plan for improvement of the eastern edge of the park. Ongoing invasive species removal was recommended by the supplier of the native vegetation for the project as a means to help ensure long term establishment of the new wetland plantings.

PURPOSE AND EXPLANATION: This change order will increase the contract amount from \$97,933.65 to \$153,561.65.

IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE: Should authorization be granted at the June 8, 2020 Committee of the Whole meeting, the remaining work will be authorized and the project will be finalized shortly thereafter.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION:

FINANCIAL SUMMARY: Change order will increase contract amount by \$55,628.00. The additional funds will be 100% covered by previously awarded grant funding through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources as a result of a recent extension granted. Additional costs will be charged to account #341-0812-56876 in the Parks City-Wide Capital Improvement Fund #341.

MOTION: Motion authorizing a change order in the amount of \$350,000.00 to Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc. for the 2020 Asphalt Road Program

BACKGROUND: Additional work was necessary on this project due to unexpectedly poor subgrade conditions on Wolff Drive and Manitoulin Pike, coupled with unseasonably heavy rainfall that occurred immediately after the milling operation which served to significantly worsen the conditions. Concrete repair quantities in this section of roadway were more than double the allotted amount for Ward 4 as a result. Going forward, it is anticipated that there will be changes in the concrete milling scope for the remaining 3 wards as a safeguard against the possibility of this type of base failure. Also, it is possible that portions of streets may be removed from the contract should it be determined that the concrete cannot be justifiably milled due to deteriorating conditions.

PURPOSE AND EXPLANATION: This change order will increase the contract amount from \$1,945,650.00 to \$2,295,650.00. The increase will be sufficient to cover the additional repairs that were encountered in Ward 4, and will also provide an allowance for a slight increase in repair quantities in the other 3 wards.

IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE: Immediately upon acceptance by Committee of the Whole

FINANCIAL INFORMATION:

FINANCIAL SUMMARY: Change order will increase contract amount by \$350,000.00. Note that the accepted bid for the project was approximately \$250,000 under the engineer's estimate. Also, note that \$60,000 was budgeted for a crack sealing program which will not be bid in 2020.
