City Manager's Report:

City Manager Carl DeForest

- Noted that Medina County was #15 in the response rate for the 2020 Census Bureau and Brunswick was #1 in the county. Mr. DeForest encouraged residents to complete their Census by online, over the phone, or do it by mail. The Census workers are scheduled to start their door to door efforts for people who did not do their Census, on August 11, 2020. The Census workers do not need to apply for a solicitor's permit.
- Remarked that the City Manager's Newsletter was sent out to residents, and the residents should receive it soon. The newsletter includes direct-dial numbers. City Hall is closed, but is open by appointments.
- Added that all local government entities in Medina County are recommending residents

to wear their face mask when out in the public. It would be mandated for Medina County to wear a mask if the county switched to the red category for an increase in Covid19 cases. He continued to remind residents to maintain social distance and wash their hands. The average age for a Covid19 positive test for the state has gone from the low 70s age range to the 40s age range.

- Reminded everyone that the Division of Fire is doing an *Adopt a Fire Hydrant Program*. Families or individuals that adopt a fire hydrant would receive 1-quart of red paint and one paintbrush to participate in the program.

Unfinished Business:

Finance Director Todd Fischer

- Stated that they are doing their part in the Income Tax Department by following all recommendations to protect everyone from Covid19. Mr. Fischer noted that residents could pay their taxes and file their taxes by E-file/E-Pay, by paper, by filling out a pre-calculated tax form on-line, contact a local CPA or schedule an appointment with the Income Tax Department to do a video conference through Google Duo.

Civil Service Commission

Councilman Joseph Delsanter wanted to know would it be helpful to adopt the appointments within this meeting. Mr. DeForest remarked that it wouldn't hurt to do that if it is okay with the Law Director. Law Director Ken Fisher noted that it depends on the Council Rules.

Mr. Fisher read the following for the record:

VI. *CONFIRMATION OF APPOINTMENTS TO BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS (Charter Section 6.01(b))*

1. *Timing of Submission of Nominees to Council:*

To facilitate Council's consideration, all proposed board or commission appointments by the Mayor under Charter Section 6.01(b) shall be submitted to Council sufficiently in advance so as to permit Council's review of same during at least one regularly scheduled Committee of the Whole meeting occurring before the date of the regularly scheduled Council meeting at which Council's confirmation of such appointment is sought.

Mr. Fisher's recommendation is that the next meeting would be the first meeting that the two new members of the Civil Service Commission could be confirmed by the City Council.

Mr. Hanek wanted to know could they make a motion to suspend the Council Rules to put the

nominations forward.

Mr. Fisher noted that it is not on the agenda, and he explained the process to add it to the agenda.

Mr. Hanek wanted to know could they add the motion to approve the recommendations for the commission appointments at the Special Committee-of-the-Whole meeting.

Mr. Fisher remarked that the Clerk of Council could add the motion to approve the appointments to the Special Committee-of-the-Whole agenda scheduled for Wednesday, July 15, 2020.

Council Meeting Audio Issue

Councilman Joseph Delsanter noted that there is an issue with the audio through Webex. He is concerned with the quality outcome for the Wednesday, July 15, 2020, Committee-of-the-Whole meeting, and the scheduled interviews. Mr. Delsanter wanted to know if Mrs. Hanek is comfortable with coming to City Hall to utilize the Wifi to decrease the chances of audio connection issues. He explained if the interviews are sloppy it would not be helpful to them.

Mrs. Hanek explained that this is the first time she has ever had technical difficulties. Mrs. Hanek remarked that she would be comfortable coming in if everyone could practice the appropriate social distance guidelines, and she does not want to be in the Caucus room by herself.

Mr. Abella explained that everyone is currently over 6 feet apart from each other.

Mr. Ousley reminded everyone that the Mayor, the City Manager, and the law director might not be at the meeting. He noted that there is plenty of room for social distancing.

Mr. Hanek remarked that he does not mind coming in, but he wants everyone to understand that there is always a possibility that one of them could be exposed to the virus or around the known positive. He encouraged that person to take advantage of the Webex option.

Mr. Delsanter reiterated that it is just a suggestion based on the observation of this meeting. He expressed that he wasn't asking every member to show up, and it is not fair to the applicants if they are not able to conduct in a fluent manner.

Mr. Ousley explained that they could quickly call Mrs. Hanek on speakerphone if there was a connection issue on Webex.

Mr. Fisher agreed with Mr. Ousley. Calling in by phone is a backup option.

Mayor Falconi noted that the issue regarding the ways of the meeting could be discussed after the meeting.

{Clerk notes: Mr. Fisher referred back to the Civil Service Commission discussion.}

Remembrance of Former Councilman Frank Raso

Mayor Ron Falconi asked for a brief silence for the passing of former Councilman Frank Raso. After the brief moment of silence, Mayor Falconi thanked Councilman Frank Raso for his service for serving the City and his thoughts and prayer are with his family during this time.

{Clerk notes: Mr. Hanek referred back to the Civil Service Commission decision.}

New Business:

There was none.

Adjournment:

Michael Abella Jr. moved to adjourn, seconded by Nicholas Hanek. Roll Call - Ayes - 6, Nicholas Hanek, Michael Abella Jr., Anthony Capretta, Joseph Delsanter, Patricia Hanek, Brian Ousley. Nays - 0. Motion Carried.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 7:41 p.m.
