MONDAY, JULY 26, 2021

Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance: The regular meeting of Brunswick City Council was called to order by Mayor Ron Falconi at 7:00 p.m. at the Municipal Complex.

Roll Call of Members showed the following Council members present: Valerie Zak, Tom Miller, Anthony Capretta, Joseph Delsanter, Brian Ousley.

Others Present: Mayor Ron Falconi, Clerk of Council Fijabi Gallam, City Manager Carl DeForest, and Law Director Ken Fisher.

Joseph Delsanter moved to excuse Councilman Michael Abella Jr, and Councilman Nicholas Hanek with just cause, seconded by Tom Miller. Roll Call - Ayes - 5, Valerie Zak, Tom Miller, Anthony Capretta, Joseph Delsanter, Brian Ousley. Nays - 0. Motion Carried.

Mayor's Report:

City Manager's Report:**City Manager Carl DeForest**

- Thanked the Mayor for the recognition of the Buddy Poppy Drive hosted by the American Legion Post #234.
- Reminded everyone that the Veterans Breakfast is scheduled for October 27, 2021, at Hilkert Hall, St. Ambrose Catholic Parish. The change of location from the Brunswick Recreation Center to the Hilkert Hall would allow for more veterans to attend the event and to practice social distancing.
- Remarked that the Police National Night Out is Tuesday, August 3, 2021, at City Hall, from 6:00 PM to 9:30 PM.
- Added that the Trike and Bike fundraiser for pediatric cancer research is scheduled for Friday, September 24, 2021, at Brunswick High School football stadium. The fundraiser is for children age 3 to 12. The City Manager's office has more information on how to participate.

Open Forum:**Road and Safety Concerns at the Heritage Park Development**

Joyce Watson, at 1199 Monroe Drive, expressed the safety and construction concerns she had at Heritage Park. Ms. Watson believed that the construction companies were not following the traffic laws. Ms. Watson added that the sewer drains that are not flushed with the ground (about 2 inches high) are a safety hazard for vehicles. She wanted to know what the plans are for the sewer system in Heritage Park.

Mayor Ron Falconi asked Ms. Watson to stay after the meeting to talk to the City Manager.

Councilman Brian Ousley added that he is aware of the area, and believed that Ms. Watson's concerns are valid and an issue. Mr. Ousley visited the area to check out the issue and the construction workers were parking on the fire hydrant side. Mr. Ousley noted that he did let the construction guys know they were parking on the wrong side.

Councilman Tom Miller wanted to get more clarification on Ms. Watson's concerns.

Ms. Watson explained that the construction workers were not following the safety guidelines.

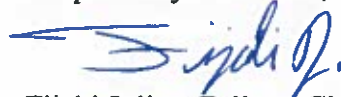
