City Manager's Report Acting City Manager Todd Fischer stated that there would be no delays for trash pick up during the holiday season. Republic Waste is now requiring mattresses, box springs, and upholstered furniture to be wrapped in plastic. He recommended that the plastic from new furniture be used to wrap old items being disposed of.

Mr. Fischer wished everyone a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year. He reminded residents that City Hall will be closed on Friday, December 23, Monday, December 26, Friday, December 30, and Monday, January 2.

New Business Kristy Piper announced that January is Pack the Pantry month in Brunswick and asked residents to bring food donations to City Hall.
