LEGISLATION: **RES. NO. 24-2024** - An emergency resolution authorizing the City Manager to purchase three (3) 2024 Ford Explorers and one (1) Ford F-150 Truck with police equipment installed for the Division of Police from Montrose Ford in an amount not to exceed \$246,500.00. - **1st Reading** (To be brought from Safety & Environment Committee, *Administration/Robert Safran*)

BACKGROUND: The city belongs to the State of Ohio Procurement program and Montrose Ford is an authorized vendor. Request to purchase vehicles through Montrose Ford.

PURPOSE AND EXPLANATION: Request to purchase (3) three marked vehicles and 1 unmarked vehicle. The requested vehicles are utilized for police patrols and response to calls for service. These replace (3) 2017 Ford Explorers in the Division of Police marked fleet and (1) one 2005 Chevy van currently utilized for S.W.A.T.

IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE: Order vehicles as soon as possible.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION:

FINANCIAL SUMMARY: The vehicles will be purchased with the Division of Police capital funds that are available and budgeted for in the 2024 Police capital budget. Cost for purchase not to exceed \$246,500 and would be charged to the Police Fund #114 capital amount 961-0520-56252.

Replacement for U8 (2017 Ford Explorer K9 vehicle) will be replaced with one (1) 2024 Ford Explorer at a cost of \$66,363.00 (includes after-market equipment).

Replacement for U26 (2005 Chevy Van S.W.A.T. vehicle) will be replaced with one (1) 2024 Ford F-150 at a cost of \$57,105.00 (includes after-market equipment).

AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE THREE (3) 2024 FORD EXPLORERS AND ONE (1) FORD F-150 TRUCK WITH POLICE EQUIPMENT INSTALLED FOR THE DIVISION OF POLICE FROM MONTROSE FORD IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$246,500.00.

WHEREAS: The City of Brunswick belongs to the Ohio State Procurement Program under the direction of the Ohio Department of Administrative Services; and

WHEREAS: The State contract under the State Procurement Program has been awarded to Montrose Ford.

WHEREAS: THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRUNSWICK HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase three (3) 2024 Ford Explorers and one (1) Ford F-150 Truck with police equipment installed for the Division of Police from Montrose Ford in an amount not to exceed \$246,500.00.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety or welfare, and for the additional reason of limited supply availability. Therefore, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the required number of votes or from the earliest time allowed by law.
