MOTION: Motion to authorize the Public Service Director to store at no charge to the City up to 1200 tons of City-owned rock salt for the 2016-2017 Winter Season at the ODOT Medina Field Office Salt Barn located at 3220 Medina Road, Medina.

BACKGROUND: During the summer there was no room left in the salt storage facilities to accept 1,200 tons of rock salt that we were required to purchase by contract.

PURPOSE AND EXPLANATION: Each year Brunswick is required to set a minimum of salt for the year. With the very light winter, we did not use much salt. Nearing the end of the contract we filled all our facilities and still needed room for 1,200 tons. ODOT had the room and offered free storage. To have the supplier store the salt would have cost between \$24,000 and \$36,000.

IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE: Our supplier delivered the salt to ODOT in the summer of 2016.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Passage of a motion which authorizes the actions of the Service Director to store 1,200 tons of rock salt at an ODOT facility until it is needed.
