AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH TAC COMPUTERS INC. FOR MAINTENANCE OF VARIOUS SOFTWARE IN THE DIVISIONS OF POLICE AND FIRE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$35,944.71.

WHEREAS: The Division of Police and Division of Fire utilize various software from TAC Computers Inc., which software requires annual maintenance.

WHEREAS: The maintenance of the software provided by TAC Computers Inc. is proprietary in nature and unique to TAC Computers Inc. and therefore not subject to competitive bidding.

WHEREAS: THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRUNSWICK HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager, with the approval of the Law Director, is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with TAC Computers Inc. for maintenance of various software in the Divisions of Police and Fire in an amount not to exceed \$35,944.71.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety or welfare, and for the additional reason that immediate passage is necessary to maintain various software in the Divisions of Police and Fire for 2025. Therefore, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the required number of votes or from the earliest time allowed by law.
