AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH INDEPENDENCE CEMENT, LLC FOR THE 2025 CONCRETE REPAIR PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$336,100.00.

WHEREAS: The City of Brunswick received seven (7) bids for the 2025 Concrete Repair Program (the “Project”), in accordance with public bidding requirements; and

WHEREAS: The seven (7) received public bids were opened on May 7, 2025, with Independence Cement, LLC determined to be the lowest and best bidder.

WHEREAS: THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRUNSWICK HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager, with the approval of the Law Director, is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with Independence Cement, LLC, the lowest and best bidder, for the 2025 Concrete Repair Program in an amount not to exceed \$336,100.00.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety or welfare, and for the additional reason that immediate passage is necessary for completion of the Project during the 2025 construction season. Therefore, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the required number of votes or from the earliest time allowed by law.
