LEGISLATION: **RES. NO. 16-17** - A resolution authorizing the City Manager to purchase two (2) ambulance power load systems and four (4) power load compatibility kits for the Division of Fire and Rescue from Stryker in an amount not to exceed \$52,422.14 - **1st Reading** (To be brought from Safety & Environment Committee, *Administration/Chief Baird*)

BACKGROUND: The Fire Department is requesting permission to purchase 2 Power Load systems for our newest ambulances. These systems load the patient and the gurney into the ambulance without the need for the crews to do it manually. This increases safety for the patient and decreases injury risk for the crew;

The proposed purchase of two (2) ambulance power load systems and four (4) power load compatibility kits for the Division of Fire and Rescue from Stryker in the amount of \$52,422.14, is upon equivalent terms, conditions and specifications and at a lower price than through the State Procurement Program.

PURPOSE AND EXPLANATION: The proposed purchase of two (2) ambulance power load systems and four (4) power load compatibility kits for the Division of Fire and Rescue from Stryker in the amount of \$52,422.14, is upon equivalent terms, conditions and specifications and at a lower price than through the State Procurement Program.

From the time of the order until the systems are installed will be 12 - 14 weeks. in order to facilitate a timely process I am requesting the 30 waiting period from council passage to authorization to purchase be waived. This will keep the entire process down to 16 to eighteen weeks;

IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE: Purchase immediately upon council approval of legislation.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE TWO (2) AMBULANCE POWER LOAD SYSTEMS AND FOUR (4) POWER LOAD COMPATIBILITY KITS FOR THE DIVISION OF FIRE AND RESCUE FROM STRYKER IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$52,422.14.

WHEREAS: The City of Brunswick belongs to the State Procurement Program under the direction of the Department of Administrative Services;

WHEREAS: Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04(C) permits the City to purchase supplies or services from another party without competitive bidding and outside the State Procurement Program if such supplies or services can be purchased under equivalent terms, conditions and specifications, but at a lower price than through the State Procurement Program; and

WHEREAS: The proposed purchase of two (2) ambulance power load systems and four (4) power load compatibility kits for the Division of Fire and Rescue from Stryker in the amount of \$52,422.14, is upon equivalent terms, conditions and specifications and at a lower price than through the State Procurement Program.

WHEREAS: THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRUNSWICK HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase two (2) ambulance power load systems and four (4) power load compatibility kits for the Division of Fire and Rescue from Stryker in an amount not to exceed \$52,422.14.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
